Fantasy Sport Camp Sponsorship Opportunities

The Johnson County Sertoma Club runs the only Deaf/Hard of Hearing Sports Camp in the Midwest. This four-day camp teaches children the skills needed to play Baseball, Soccer and Lacrosse. Our participants get the opportunity to interact with other deaf/hard of hearing children, as well as role models within the deaf community. During camp, the children receive instruction from our head coaches who are also deaf/hard of hearing. Interpreters are provided so the participants get the maximum benefit from their hands-on instruction! As an added bonus, the participants and their families will attend a Kansas City T-Bones game in celebration of the fun-filled experience.

Scholarship Sponsor: \$100 – Sponsor a child's attendance to the Fantasy Sports Camp!

Water Bottle Sponsor: \$200 - Corporate logo printed on water bottle provided to each participant and posted on camp website.

The proceeds from our sponsorships help us offset the costs of the camp and support our other major community service project, our HEARTT program. The HEARTT program stands for HEAR Today and Tomorrow. We have built a library of hearing aids for temporary use by newborns who are diagnosed as profoundly hearing impaired. This saves the family the cost of hearing aids (\$5000 to \$6000) while the doctors are deciding on a treatment course for the child.
