Sertoma was founded on April 11, 1912 in Kansas City, Missouri. Under the original name of the Co-Operative Club, it grew into an international organization.

In 1953, the name was changed to Sertoma: for its motto: Service to Mankind.

The Johnson County Sertoma club was chartered on September 1, 1999 when members from the Leawood, Shawnee Mission and Metropolitan Fantasy Sports Sertoma clubs merged. The Shawnee Mission Sertoma club was chartered in 1935, the Leawood Sertoma club was chartered in 1995 and the Metropolitan Fantasy Sports club was chartered in 1997.
